- 4. Congratulations to all the newly elected officers of the Posts and Districts. I look forward to working with all of you this year.
- 5. Please remember that our Department Headquarters office staff is there to help you in any way they possibly can, please feel free to call or e-mail them.
- 6. <u>MEMBERSHIP</u>, I would like to remind all of you of that the Membership Program is once again the number one issue that all Post Officers MUST work on to bring the posts and department back up to 100% With just a little effort on the part of the members of your post, you can add much needed new members to your roster. If you need the names of those members that are about to fall off the rolls of the VFW please contact me, a department officer or district commander for that information.
- 7. Our State Adjutant/Quartermaster has set up our e-mail address books at Department Headquarters. If you were listed as a post officer on the Post Election Report, you will be receiving all of the department e-mails. We ask that you do not send back any cartoons, jokes or other non business items. Our goal is to have someone from every post in our address book that will pass on the information sent out to the other comrades in the post. If the Post Commander does not have e-mail, then a member of the post who does, should be asked to receive and pass on the information. We will also be very happy to add any of our Comrades, Sisters and Brothers to our e-mail address book who care to be in it.
- 7/A Remember only a 10 minutes call once a week to your delinquent member or a potential new member may be all you need to get to 100%.
- 8. It is the responsibility of each Post Commander to see that their Post is properly represented at District meetings and Department functions. Each Post has a minimum of 11 elected and appointed officers, and if the Post Commander is unable to attend then the Post Commander should assign one of them to attend a district meeting each month. That would have a member from each post at every district meeting, without the same person going every month, although they may.
- 8/A Failure of a post not to send a representative to the meetings (without a just reason) may result in the removal of the post commander from his/her office.
- 9. The Commander-in-Chief has reminded us that only official VFW caps are allowed at VFW meetings (No baseball caps or other style hats) and that it is objectionable for anyone to consume alcoholic beverages at any VFW meeting. However the National By-
 - Laws now provide for a informal post meeting to be held, and baseball caps are allowed at those meetings.

Veteran Recipient Criteria

- Must be able to provide a DD214
- Must fall below the Geographic Income Threshold for your county, reference VA's
 Means Test for Priority group 8
- National Income Limits
- Have a valid driver's license
- Have a clean driving record no major infractions in the past 7 years.
- Be able to insure and maintain the vehicle
- Does not own a vehicle or show a hardship with current vehicle
- One Year Income Tax
- Must be able to pass a background check

Veteran Recipient's Legal Obligations and Liabilities

- Title transfer fees
- Pay all applicable sales tax and fees after 1yr of ownership
- Insurance coverage after the first six months of ownership

Please remember that the recipient is legally required to obtain and continue insurance coverage.
